- Athletes who reached the qualifying standards during the AFS Provincial Champs will be selected, if qualifying standards are not met, it will be the selectors prerogative if the athletes be selected or not.
- All athletes must obtain 2024 AFS License
- Appeal will cost R500 and team managers must submit 30 minutes after the event, appeal forms will be available at the TIC

GENERAL RULES

- The Athletics Meeting will be held in line with WA, ASA & AFS rules and regulations
- All athletes must participate with 2024 ASA permanent license; athlete's entry fee is R40 per athlete. Athletes not in possession of 2024 ASA license will have to purchase a temporary license at the gate at a cost of R50 and will be accepted for League 1, further leagues athletes must obtain a permanent license.
- License must be worn in front and back, jumps events may wear one.
- Spectators Fee is R50 each and Children under 6 years is free (must produce birth certificate on request)
- Entries for all athletes will be on the southern side of the stadium for athletes and spectators. Athlete must have their running license when paying or request a temporary license on the first league meeting. **NB: No Temporary License will be sold on the day of the second meeting**
- Entries for the leagues will be done online via a link to be supplied by the organizers
- Athletes must participate in 3 events
- Starting Blocks will be compulsory for sprint events from 9 years.
- Best 8 times will participate in the final in Boy and Girls U13 100 and 200m events
- Athletes must participate in their respective club/school colors, neutral white and non-branded colors will be accepted.
- AFS records for Track will be accepted through the usage of electronic timing
- Records (Leagues and AFS Championships) are combined to ensure that only one set of records will be used in future.
- Sick notes to be handed in before the League meeting
- NO PARTICIPATION IN AFS PROVINCIAL COLOURS

COMPETITION RULES

- 1. In the heats, World Athletics technical rule 20(TR20) will apply unless stipulated that event is run as final with more than one heat, then results will be determined on fastest times.
- 2. If there are insufficient entrants in the heats, the race becomes a final and WILL BE RUN AT THE SCHEDULED TIME OF THE FINAL.
- 3. Where events are considered to be finals and more entries are received that can be accommodated in a final, more than one race can be run and results will then be determined on the fastest times.
- 4. Athletes must report at the CALL ROOM 60 minutes before the published time schedule NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED
- 5. <u>Implements</u>: Competitors may use their own implements, provided these are checked before competition by the Technical Manager. These implements can only be used by other athletes with the permission of the owner of the implement (competition specific rule). Personal implements, with the owner's name on it, must be handed in at the equipment room not later than 3 hours before the official starting time of the event. No competitor shall be permitted to take any implement into the arena. At the end of the competition, athletes shall leave the field carrying their own implements
- 6. Athletes are not permitted to have in their possession cell phones, cassette recorders, radio, iPods, MP3s etc., or any other communication device, in the competition arena (WA TR 6.3.2).

- 7. At the competition area before the beginning of the event, each field athlete may have practice trials. In the case of throwing events, the practice trials will be in draw order and always under the supervision of the Judges (WA TR 25.1).
- 8. Once the competition has begun, competitors are not permitted to use implements, runways or circles for practice or warm-up purposes (WA TR 25.2).
- 9. All competition shoes must comply with the World Athletics Technical Rules (TR 5.2) and the Athletic Shoe Regulations approved by the World Athletics Council on 22 December 2021. Where any Referee has a reasonable suspicion that a shoe worn by an athlete in a competition might not comply with the letter or the spirit of the Rules, the Referee may request, and the athlete must immediately hand over the shoe to the Referee at the conclusion of the event, for further investigation (WA Shoe Regulation 14.7).
- 10. A competitor shall be excluded from further participation in the championships in cases where:
- 11. 1 A final confirmation was given that the athlete would start in an event but then failed to participate (WA TR 4.4.1).
- He/she qualified in preliminary rounds or heats for further participation in an event but then failed to participate further (WA TR 4.4.2).
- 11.2 Note: Athletes, who withdraw from an event during the championship due to medical reasons, will only be considered for selection to represent Athletic Free State, if cleared by a medical doctor and a fitness test is done under the supervision of an AFS Delegate.
 - 12. Starting blocks supplied by the organizers must be used
 Starting blocks is compulsory from 9 years and older for all Track event up to 400m
 - 13. Heats and Qualifications:
 - 13.1 All events except 100m and 200m, Boys and Girls 13 will be finals
 - 13.2 Due to the duration of Vertical Jump events, there will be starting heights.

14 Publication of Results:

- 14.1The designated Service Provider will provide a LINK for results and the results will be paperless. Draw list for each event (heats and finals) as well as the results of each event will be communicated via the LINK.
- 15 Only Athletes domiciled in the ASA demarcated districts of Athletics Free State may compete in the Athletics Free State Provincial Championships and AFS Talent Identification competition, unless otherwise determined by the Chairperson of AFS Track & Field Commission.

ATHLETES CONTROL CENTRE

- 1. The call room for the athletes will be situated at the warm up area. All athletes must report to the call-room. If an athlete is entered in both track and field events which takes place simultaneously, the Team Manager must report this to the Control Room at least one (1) hour prior to the start of the first event.
- 2. When the control has been completed an official will accompany the athletes to the waiting area and final control point.
- 3. Only athletes and official Team Managers will be allowed in the call room (i.e. no parents, coaches etc.)

4. Athletes call out times will be as follows:

- 5. At registration, 2 bib numbers will be issued to each athlete. During the competition, athletes must always wear the numbers in their original shape and size properly secured on the four corners with the exception of athletes in the Jumping Events where only one number is compulsory (WA TR 5.7). Any athlete who does not respect these rules will not be allowed to compete.
- 6. Competitors taking part in track events might be given a supplementary number which they must attach on the right hip (WA TR 5.10).
- 7. NO PARENT TO BE ALLOWED IN THE CALL ROOM AND WARMUP AREA
- 8. Custody of Clothing:
- 8.1 All competitors competing in track events will receive a basket at the start, for his/her clothes. Basket carriers will take the basket to the mixed zone. There will be a lane mark on each basket in order to make it easier for the athletes to locate their basket after the event.

VICTORY CEREMONY

- 1. The first three athletes in each final event must report to the victory ceremonies area 30 minutes before the time of the victory ceremony. The victory ceremony will be held according to the victory ceremony program distributed at the technical meeting.
- 2. Please note that athletes must be dressed in their club/school colours (full track suit / competition attire and sneakers), as the victory ceremony is part of the competition. Failure to comply will result in the athlete not being allowed to be part of the ceremony (WA TR 5.1).

TECHNICAL DATA

- 1. Electronic timing will be used, and hand timing will be provided as a back- up.
- 2. A video recording may be used as back-up for Place Judges and during appeals.
- 3. The measurement of distances at the field events shall be by means of a fibre measuring tape, but all records will be measured by a steel measuring tape. We are also looking at introducing laser measuring devices at these Championships for all field events
- 4. The starting heights and increments for High Jump will be confirmed at the Technical Meeting.
- 5. All Team Managers must collect their team's race numbers from **12h00 15h50** on Thursday, 21 November 2024 at Athletics Free State Offices at Managung Athletic Stadium.
- 6. Final confirmation of athletes entered must be given at that time. Any withdrawals and corrections should also be addressed during that time as no further corrections will be accepted on any day after the commencement of the competition. No late entries will be accepted after 21 November 2024.

7. Any further withdrawals of athletes for specific events must be done by 16:00 on the day prior to the competition, as draw sheets will then be compiled for the next day of competition.

MEDICAL SERVICES

- 1. A full emergency medical service with an ambulance will be available at the stadium.
- 2. Athletes who belong to a medical scheme must bring their membership cards with, in case they are required due to injuries.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- 1. Protest shall be made in accordance with WA Technical Rule 8. During the course of the event an athlete or his/her Team Manager may lodge a verbal protest to the appropriate Referee.
- 2. All appeals must be made in writing on the prescribed appeal form, which can be obtained from the Technical Information Centre (TIC). All appeal forms must be signed by the athlete or Team Manager.
- 3. The appeal must be submitted to the TIC, accompanied by a deposit of R500, no later than 30 minutes after the official announcement of the results, which is the defined time when the result are posted on the official Results links.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION CENTRE

1. The TIC will be located in the main stadium. The precise location will be communicated during the team managers' meeting.

TECHNICAL MANAGER'S OFFICE

- 1. The office of the Technical Manager is located at the stadium.
- 2. The Technical Manager's/ assizing room is situated under the main pavilion of the stadium and will be clearly marked.

VISITS TO THE STADIUM

- 1. A visit to the stadium shall be organized for Team Managers to show the exact location of the main facilities.
- 2. The visit shall take place Thursday, 21 November 2024.
- 3. The track will be available to athletes and Coaches on Thursday, 21 November 2024, from 12:00 to 16:00 for visiting and training.

RESULTS

Results will be posted on the LINK provided as soon as it is available. A complete set of results will be emailed to all clubs/schools after the last day of the championships. Results will only be available on the internet LINK which will be provided during the Managers Meeting on 21 November **2024.**

Selection criteria of AFS Track & Field Sub Youth Interprovincial Team

The following criteria must be met for the selection to the AFS team to participate in the ASA Sub Youth Interprovincial Championship.

1. Certified copies of birth certificate or ID must be submitted to the AFS Track and Field Commission with

- a photo not later than the closing date of entries for the ASA Sub Youth Interprovincial Championships.
- 2. Athletes must be in possession of a 2024 ASA/AFS permanent athlete license number before he/she may be considered for selection to the AFS Team takes. This number also acts as an insurance policy should the athlete be injured training or participating at an event.
 - Minimum qualification standard (attached) must be reached per item during AFS Sub Youth Championships.
 - It remains the prerogative of the selection committee to waive any qualifying standard should it be deemed necessary to do so.
